### **REACH Statement**


REACH is a new European Union regulation concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of Chemicals. It came into force on 1st June 2007 and replaces a number of European Directives and Regulations with a single system.

BI Technologies Ltd is committed to meeting the requirements set out in the REACH regulations. We are currently working with our suppliers in regard of pre registration and registration of chemicals supplied to us that are used to make our products.

REACH covers chemical substances as such, in preparations or in articles, intended to be released.

Our products do not fall into the category of articles 'with intent for release' therefore at this time we do not need to provide our customers with any additional documentation. At present we do not anticipate any disruptions of product supplies to our customers.

#### Additional information on Articles

An article is the legal term under REACH for any object that has been given a specific shape, surface or design so that it can be used for a specific purpose (e.g. manufactured goods such as cars, textiles, electronic chips).

REACH requires all substances that are intended to be released from articles during normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use to be registered according to the normal rules, if they are produced or imported in quantities exceeding 1 tonne/year per producer or importer.

Such notification is not required, however, when exposure to humans and environment can be excluded during normal conditions of use, including disposal, and this applies to products manufactured by BI Technologies Ltd.
